Expression of interest

St Julian's Parish wishes to re-decorate the interior of the Church in time for the celebration of the one hundred and twenty-fifth anniversary of its establishment as a parish in 1891.

The Parish is therefore inviting interior designers, decorators, architects, and any person who feels confident and capable of preparing a coherent design-and-execute scheme, to submit a detailed colour scheme for the interior, indicating the quantum of the fees for the designs, together with a firm cost of the actual painting work, including all material, scaffolding, and requisite tools.

The painting scheme will replace the present one which was unveiled for the visit of Pope John Paul II in 1990. The presentation format is left up to each individual participant, but it is expected to be of a professional standard, and it must clearly show how the colour scheme will work; also 30 by 30cm samples of all proposed colours must be included. This will enable the judging panel to understand fully the intended design so as to come to a proper and informed decision. The amounts of the fees and the cost of the painting work should be presented in a separate, sealed A4 brown paper envelope. This information will only be disclosed to the panel after the submitted designs have been reviewed.

Any interested persons who intend to participate should register with the Parish on email: parrocca.san.giljan@maltadiocese.org or by phoning 21380270, by 15th December 2014. This will enable participants to visit and inspect the church outside of religious services. The submission date for the design submittal is 9th February 2015. The painting work is envisaged to start in May 2015 and be concluded before the feast of St Julian at the end of August.
